Dear Friend of Hospice Orillia,

The past year has provided us with the opportunity to review and reflect on many aspects of our lives. One aspect many of us failed to think about often, until the recent pandemic, is end of life, grief and bereavement.

At Hospice Orillia, we believe that death, grief and bereavement are all a part of life, a rite of passage. There is much that can be done to help individuals and their families face this time with dignity and quality in their lives.

As with many other aspects of our lives, the way we operate as a visiting hospice has changed. Everything from the number of volunteers to the number of individuals looking for support to the amount of financial support we have received, have all adjusted the way we operate.

The one thing that has not changed has been the ongoing need for end of life, grief and bereavement support in our community.

While we have accomplishments to celebrate from the past year, there is still so much work to be done.

The number of calls we have received for a visiting volunteer services and bereavement support have increased to the point that we now have a waiting list where clients are waiting to be matched. No one should have to sit on a waiting list, especially when living with a life limiting illness or grieving the loss of a loved one.

Many aspects can affect a waiting list; volunteer availability is our number one hurdle with funding being the second.

As a community based hospice, we receive partial funding from the government and rely on the support of our community to fill in where that funding falls short.

The support we receive from the community helps to ensure we are able to continue to provide the following:

- Visiting volunteer services (including respite).
- Complementary copies of their personalized Footprints book.
- Garden of Remembrance and Candle of Remembrance memorial events.
- Grief and bereavement support via one-on-one and group programs.
- Pregnancy and infant loss support program.

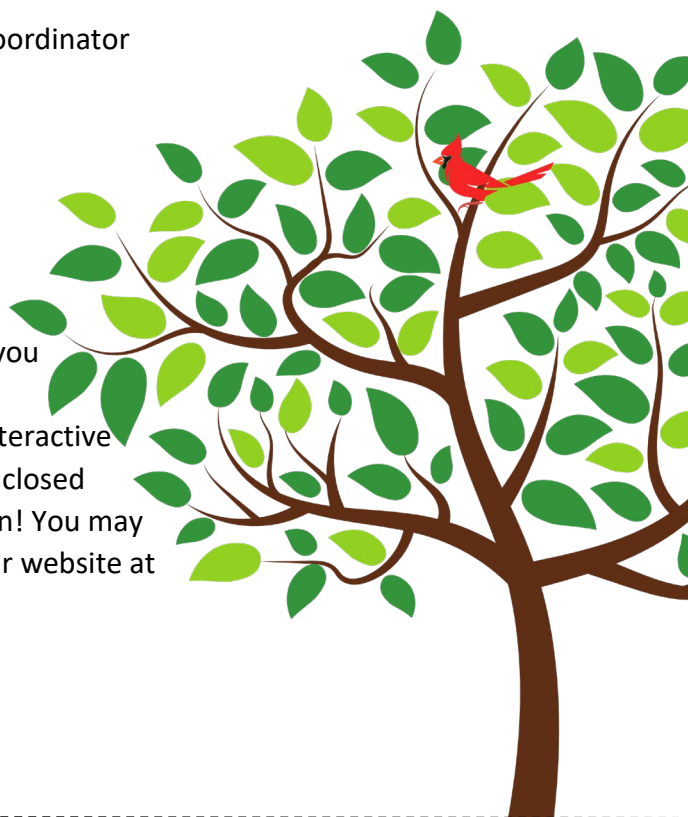
