Please note that those referring on behalf of another individual will be required to provide some basic information to complete the referral, and must do so with consent from the individual.

## WHAT IS HOSPICE

Hospice care is a type of health care that focuses on individuals who are living with progressive and terminal illnesses. Hospice care aims to care for the whole person including their physical, social, psychological and spiritual needs, and prioritizes the individual's comfort and quality of life while aligning with a person's goals.

# UNDERSTANDING WHAT YOU'RE FEELING

<u>Grief:</u> The reaction to the loss of a loved one. It can also be a reaction to the loss of relationships, physical ability, opportunities or future hopes and dreams.

<u>Bereavement:</u> The state of having suffered the loss of a loved one. It is the time after a loss during which grief is experienced and mourning occurs.

Anticipatory Grief: The feeling of grief occurring before the death of someone close due to illness. A terminally ill individual may also feel this about their impending death.
